



FROM CLAY TO COTTON:

Stories of Strength from Odisha's Women Entrepreneurs



For generations, the women of Odisha have quietly shaped their families and communities. Today, through SUBHADRA, they are stepping into the spotlight—not just as caregivers, but as economic leaders, cultural anchors, and agents of change.

Inspired by the strength of Goddess Subhadra and the government's vision for inclusive growth, SUBHADRA places women at the core of Odisha's development journey. With ₹10,000 annually for five years, credited directly into their bank accounts on Rakhi Purnima and International Women's Day, the initiative ensures financial independence and dignity for every eligible woman aged 21 to 60.

But SUBHADRA goes beyond financial support. It's a comprehensive platform for empowerment, in tegrating skill-building, education, and entrepreneurship. With initiatives like Kuho SUBHADRA, SUBHADRA Samikhya, and Kisori SUBHADRA, it aims to reach women from every corner of Odisha.

This is more than a scheme. This is GHARE GHARE SUB-HADRA.

Subhadra: A Journey of Empowerment

On 17th September 2024, SUBHAD-RA was launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister in Odisha—marking more than just a policy rollout, but the beginning of a powerful movement. In a single day, ₹1,250 crore reached over 25 lakh women, reinforcing the state's commitment to women-led development. Since then, over 1 crore women have benefited, with 41.1% from SC/ST communities. Designed through a bottom-up, participatory

approach, SUBHADRA reflects Odisha's vision for inclusive growth, backed by an ambitious ₹55,825 crore outlay over five years.

With 150+ consultations across departments, SUBHADRA was built on transparency, technology, and reach. The SUBHADRA portal, Kuho call centre, and biometric eKYC ensure efficient and secure delivery, even in remote areas. Benefits are credited directly via DBT and CBDC, with over 1 lakh digital wallet transactions already processed.

To raise awareness, the SUB-HADRA Sachetanata Rath traversed districts and Panchayats. Through hoardings, community rallies, and SHG outreach, the scheme ensured no woman was left behind. On Women's Day,

over 1 crore SUBHADs lit lamps in celebration—a glowing symbol of transformation.

What truly defines SUBHAD-RA, however, are the stories it enables: a goat farmer in Nuapada increasing her income, an artisan in Rayagada reviving bamboo crafts, or a young girl in Balasore finally pursuing her dream to teach.

Across Odisha, women are no longer just caregivers—they are entrepreneurs, leaders, and changemakers. This is GHARE GHARE SUBHADRA—a movement lighting homes and futures, one empowered woman at a time.







Menaka Pradhan, Artisan: Bamboo Craft

Limited by raw materials, Menaka couldn't meet rising demand for her bamboo craft. With SUBHADRA's help, she invested in superior-quality bamboo, improving durability and market appeal. Now, her business is steadily expanding.



Tikili Rana, Artisan: Pottery

For Tikili, pottery was a family tradition, but sustaining it as a business was tough. Aided by SUBHADRA, she secured better clay and tools, boosting efficiency and product quality. Her handcrafted pieces now attract buyers from beyond her village.



Sushma Jharia, Entrepreneur: Cotton Wicks

Running a cotton wick business required consistency in supply, but Sushma lacked the capital to expand. A ₹5,000 investment through SUBHADRA allowed her to increase production, fulfill larger orders, and reach new customers. With business thriving, she now has the confidence to take her trade further.



Daru Phulma Hikka, Farmer: Goatery





SpiceJet Reports Highest-Ever Quarterly Profit and Second Consecutive Profitable Quarter

Q4 FY25 Profit Surges 12 times to INR 319 Crore Airline Posts First Annual Profit in Seven Years

SpiceJet's Net Worth Turned Positive in the Third Quarter of FY25 and Remained Positive in the Fourth Quarter, Reaching INR 683 Crore

Operating Revenue Jumps 17.5% to INR 1,446 Crore; Registers Strong Passenger Load Factor of 88.1%; Operating RASK Increases to INR 5.66

SpiceJet Ltd. announced its financial results for the fourth quarter and full year ending March 31, 2025. The airline posted its highest-ever quarterly profit of INR 319 Crore for Q4 FY25, marking its second consecutive profitable quarter, and a full-year net profit of INR 48 Crore – the first in seven years – underscoring the success of its financial and operational turnaround strategy.

Driven by improved yields, sustaining high load factors, and cost optimization, SpiceJet's revenue for Q4 FY25 rose 17.6% QoQ to INR 1,942 Crore, while EBITDA increased to INR 527 Crore from INR 209 Crore in the last quarter. The Passenger Load Factor stood at 88.1%, highlighting strong demand.

For the fiscal year ended March 31, 2025, the airline posted a net profit of INR 48 Crore, a remarkable recovery from a loss of INR 404 Crore in FY24. Revenue for the year stood at INR 6,736 Crore. Passenger RASK improved by 3.4% YoY, and the airline has achieved a positive net worth of INR 683 Crore at the end of the period.

The Promoter Group completed an equity infusion of INR 500 Crore, including the final tranche of INR 294.09 Crore in Q4 FY25, underscoring its strong confidence in the company's long-term vision and potential.

Ajay Singh, Chairman and Managing Director, SpiceJet, said, "As we share our quarterly and annual performance today, our thoughts are with those affected by the tragic Air India crash in Ahmedabad. This heartbreaking tragedy has deeply affected us all, and our thoughts are with the families and loved ones of those lost in this devastating crash. The entire aviation community stands together in this moment of grief."

"SpiceJet has delivered a strong set of results, marking a significant turnaround in our operational and financial performance. Posting a profit for the second consecutive quarter and for the full financial year after seven years is a reflection of the tireless efforts of our team, the continued trust of our passengers, and the resilience of our brand. With a strengthened balance sheet, renewed investor trust and continued network expansion, SpiceJet is well-positioned for sustainable growth."


"While the revival of our grounded fleet has taken longer than anticipated due to complex global supply chain and engine overhaul challenges, momentum is now clearly building. With overhauled engines now returning, we expect a steady ramp-up in operational capacity in the weeks ahead."

Chrocount Where nature meets serenity

o you know there is a song titled 'Dehra Dun' by the late George Harrison from the Beatles group? Such has been the allure of Doon Valley that it inspires limitless creativity. Reminisced as one of the rarest Beatles songs, this one was composed in the spring of 1968 when the group had visited Dehradun during their sojourn in Rishikesh. Today, the city may have transformed into a bustling hotspot but remains enveloped in its oldworld charms. Nestled between the Himalayan foothills and the Shivalik ranges. Dehradun lives up to its Garhwali name where 'Dehra' means dera, griha or abode and 'Doon' implies valley. The vibrant city entices with its quintessential colonial charm, cultural brotherhood, spectacular surroundings and rich cultural tapestry, making it worthy of a weekend retreat rather than a brief stopover.

Many a times, I have glided past the city to reach the hills of Mussoorie or the towering altitudes of Garhwal Himalayan region of Uttarakhand, but last year, a friend's wedding presented me an opportunity to spend a week in the city and experience it in a different perspective. I had always known Dehradun for its esteemed institutions like Oil and Natural Gas Corporation Limited, the Zoological Survey of India, Wadia Institute of Himalayan Geology, Survey of India, and the prestigious Doon School, Welham Girls School, Indian Military Academy (IMA), and Forest Research Institute (FRI), but what I discovered during my stay is that the city captivates with its delightful year-round climate, charming cafes and bakeries, heritage monuments, numerous village hiking routes, and spirited bazaars.

Spring, Waterfall and Caves

Nestled between the Song River, a tributary of Ganga, and the Asan River, a tributary of Yamuna on the west, Dehradun exemplifies the all-season, year-round destination. The springs and caves are major attractions: Sahastradhara or the 'Thousand-fold Spring' is emblematic of Dehradun. The peaceful ambiance renders it a perfect retreat for nature enthusiasts. I recollect witnessing these caves as a child (for the first time) and being spellbound by the limestone stalactites. Another destination is the Robber's cave or 'Gucchu Pani'- a natural cave formation and intersecting water stream. The cave's folklore of erstwhile robbers' hideout enhances its allure.


Spiritual and tranquil attractions

Another must visit during my visits are Dehradun's spiritual treasures. Just six kilometres from the city's bustling heart lies the Tapkeshwar Cave Temple, a sanctuary where devotion drips literally from the rocks – each drop blessed by Lord Shiva himself. It is believed that the legendary guru Dronacharya found solitude here.

Yet another destination is the Mindrolling Monastery. A masterpiece of Tibetan architecture – its vibrant murals tell tales of Buddhist philosophy. The chanting of monks creates an otherworldly soundtrack to your exploration.

For those willing to venture further, Kalsi, 90 kilometres away from the city, is a visitor's paradise. This hidden hamlet in Chakrata safeguards one of Emperor Ashoka's rock edicts, its ancient inscriptions whispering stories of dharma across millennia.

The journey culminates at Tapovan Ashram, where yogis and seekers find their centre amidst pristine woodlands.



celebrated heights of Mussoorie, Dhanaulti, and Landour - it's a treasure chest of hidden gems.

Cycling is one of the most fun activities in Dehradun. One may find several leisure cycling tracks in the city starting from Rajpur road. The Old Dehradun-Mussoorie Road is one of my favourites for hiking as well as cycling.

Wildlife enthusiasts will find their nirvana in Rajaji National Park, where every rustle in the undergrowth promises a potential photograph.

Don't forget to visit the iconic trinity of Kempty Falls, Gun Hill, and Mall Road in Mussoorie which stands ready to provide that perfect finale to your Dehradun adventure.



Nepal, the kingdom of high mountains and shrines — both Hindu and Buddhist — boasts a rich culinary heritage, one that is shaped by ethnicity (there are as many as 125 ethnic groups in the country), terrain, geographic diversity, and climate, and also influenced by neighbours India, China and Tibet.

A large part of this Himalayan nation is cold for much of the year, and so hardy crops like buckwheat, millet, beans, and high-altitude rice are eaten. And because of the chilly weather, locals often prefer warm nourishments such as soup, Thukpa (a Tibetan noodle soup) and tea, besides strong alcoholic drinks like rice beer. Here is our list of must-try foods and beverages in Nepal



Dal Bhat

The best and most ubiquitous meal in Nepal, Dal Bhat consists of rice and lentils paired with vegetables or meat. Served all over the country, this dish was initially a simple meal of steamed rice and lentil soup with spices, filled with carbs and protein, and eaten by farmers and labourers across the land. Now it's also accompanied by meat and vegetables. This is a standard fare in Nepal, and is available in most of the local eateries.





Drinks for every occasion

Alcoholic drinks such as Chyang, Raksi, and Aila are deeply rooted in the country's customs and also served at religious rituals, festivals, and social gatherings. Aila, or rice beer, is prepared in every household and had by all; besides rice, it is also made from grains like millet and barley. Chiya, Nepali tea, is a staple. Herbal teas, made from a variety of plants and spices, have been a part of traditional Nepali medicine for centuries.



Deep-fried Sel rotis, which look like doughnuts, are sold as street food and usually eaten for breakfast. Made from rice flour, water, sugar, ghee and spices, these rotis are served across the country, during festivals as well as at wedding parties and other ceremonies. It's also the ceremonial bread of the Nepali New Year.

Gundruk

A side dish of fermented leafy vegetables, Gundruk is usually eaten during the off season. The shredded greens are kept in warm water in an earthen pot for about a week. Once they have turned slightly acidic, they are left to dry in the sun before being stored.





Samay Baji

A traditional and signature dish of the Newaris, Samay Baji is usually served during festivals, with assorted items on a single plate. Varieties of fried black soybeans, Aloo Saag, Choyela (grilled meat), puffed rice, egg, vegetable preparations, and Achaar – a medley of vegetables pickled in spices and oil – are placed on a platter and served. These bites were customarily carried by farming families, and did not need to be reheated or recooked.

Thakali Thali

Thakali is the cuisine of Nepalese hailing from the Pokhara and Mustang areas, who were traders. Since they lived in the higher reaches, many of their vegetables were dried before being cooked. Typically, a Thakali Thali would include dried goat and yak meat, fermented leafy greens (also known as Gundruk) with soybean, along with buckwheat, barley flour, and a spiced tomato pickle. Timur, a zesty Himalayan pepper, is what makes Thakali food distinct; it is the dried outer pod of the berry of a tree from the prickly ash family, which is used to flavour soups, vegetables and gravies.



Food you can't miss

Have a meal at Krishnarpan at The Dwarika Hotel in Kathmandu. Here, dishes from different regions are served on metal platters, by women dressed in the traditional costumes of each region. Another great place to eat - and one with a chef's table - is The Nanee, a boutique hotel in Bhaktapur which has a rooftop restaurant as well as one on the ground floor. In Patan, I would recommend a Thakali platter at Jimbu Thakali by Capital Grill, and Raithaane, which has vegan options. And for a meal with a view, head to The Dwarika's Resort in Dhulikhel.

Juju Dhau

An essential part of the diet, especially in Bhaktapur, Juju Dhau, or king of curd, is a sweetened curd made from the milk of the buffalo, which is set in mud pots. It is relished for its rich taste and creamy consistency. Mixed with beaten rice, the curd is a popular snack among the Newari community, for whom it is also a ceremonial food














You trained at NSD and then went to Drama Studio London. What were the major differences in the way acting is taught in these spaces?


Fundamentally, I saw that in India we focused, theoretically but sporadically, on wholesome development and understanding of art and craft, and social history - that includes human history; history of art, architecture, literature, ancient literature; modern Western, ancient and modern Indian history, and more. It includes the relevant parts which are connected to artistic understanding, like how humans have been shaped all through the years, how human behaviour changed in terms of art, from cave paintings to surrealism and postmodernism, from Ajanta-Ellora and Southeast Asian paintings to minimalism from Japan. and so on. All these are comprehensive in theory.



The downside is that it is probably too much in too short a time. Quite often, students would get confused. Some of them come from different backgrounds, from remote villages and towns in Tamil Nadu, or Nagaland, or Mizoram, and are not necessarily exposed to art and the artistic world, so it is difficult for them to grasp so quickly. But it has an advantage, in that when you churn it, and munch on it with time, you understand, 'Oh, it was that!' (Laughs).

In comparison, the training I got in the UK was very categorised, extremely disciplined, and focused on the fundamental aspects of a craft - for example, characterisation. The teacher could be trained in two different schools of thought, could be from Stanislavski's school of thought, or Lecoq or Grotowski's. And he/she would be giving you both practical and theory, thoroughly, in her conversation. Then there would be the focus on the body and voice.




It is said that directors/producers give what the public wants, in terms of songs or films that are not so aesthetic. What is your take on this?

No! I don't believe in that. We as artistes and filmmakers have great responsibility. Films have the power to mould public opinion, and there are several examples from around the world to prove that. If someone blames it on the public, either he is lying, or he is being foolish, or trying to avoid taking responsibility and accountability as a filmmaker. It is in our hands, and it has to be from a space or place of integrity, to see what kind of society we are trying to create for the next generation. After we pass, what will our action teach them? Is my action only to make some money? Or is it going to give them something of value and substance for a lifetime? If the answer is money, then we as film creators are not creating films but a product, like a toothpaste or soap.

Do you like to travel? If yes, where all have you travelled?

I have been an avid traveller. Travels have changed my life for the better. I spent two years, in 1995/96, travelling on a motorbike crisscrossing the country, because I wanted to feel the weather (and) its grind on my body. I started from Delhi. My first stop was south of Madhya Pradesh, now Chhattisgarh; three months in



Jagdalpur. We went to the Gond and Bharia tribal regions, lived with them, dressed, danced, hunted and ate like them. Then we crossed the belly of the country, nearly all the states; went to Pune, Mumbai, Goa, then to Pondicherry and Kerala, back to Delhi, and again to the south. When you are on a bike, it's like being on horseback; you are at the mercy of the elements. I bathed in the river, slept under the trees and at the houses of strangers, who welcomed me with different kinds of food.

How have your travels enriched your personal and professional journey?

Two years of travel changed my view about India. Before that, I would go to the UK, do Shakespeare and all, but the travel within my own country showed me that wisdom is available in every nook and cranny without having to pay a penny. But you have to have an incessant curiosity to know, understand and fathom the answers to your questions, all the time. I met illiterate but incredible people who taught me the wisest things in life. You learn so much about a new culture and behaviour, and diversify your thoughts about the human condition, ideas and ideologies, which make you a largehearted person. You become more accepting, and your sense of empathy intensifies.

Your forthcoming ventures?

'Secret of the Mountain Serpent', directed by Nidhi Saxena, will premiere at the Venice Film Festival. 'Clouds Have Bridges Too' directed by Wanphrang Diengdoh, who also directed my first film, 'Lorni - the Flaneur'
