Rethinking venture-building through systems, scale, and structure



In a world where entrepreneurship is often seen as a one-founder, one-company journey, a new approach is emerging - one that focuses not on building individual businesses, but on building the systems that create them.

In this edition of Spice Route, we speak with Dr. Dhiraj Jain, Founder & Chairman of 1XL Holdings, and Dr. Mamata Dhiraj Jain, Founder & Managing Director of 1XL Holdings, about what it really takes to build a platform capable of supporting 100+ ventures.



The idea of building 100+ ventures challenges the traditional view of entrepreneurship. What prompted this shift in thinking?

Dr. Dhiraj Jain: Because the traditional model, while powerful, is not easily scalable. If every business depends entirely on individual effort, then building multiple ventures becomes difficult. The shift was to move from thinking about individual businesses to thinking about repeatable systems.

So is the real focus not the companies themselves, but the system behind them?

Dr. Mamata Dhiraj Jain: Exactly. When you build a strong system, it can support multiple ventures. The idea is not to start from scratch every time, but to create a structure that can be applied across different opportunities.

When you say "systems-driven," what does that actually mean in simple terms?

Dr. Dhiraj Jain: It means bringing structure into areas that are usually left to chance. Instead of relying purely on instinct, we define clear frameworks that can guide how businesses are built and supported.

Traditionally, entrepreneurship has been very personal and unstructured. Does a systems approach change that dynamic?

Dr. Mamata Dhiraj Jain: It doesn't remove the personal element, but it supports it. Founders still bring vision and leadership, but they operate within a structured environment that reduces uncertainty and improves consistency.

Why choose a platform-based business?

Dr. Dhiraj Jain: Speed, scale, and repeatability matter most. Strong systems eliminate reinvention, accelerate growth, improve efficiency, and repeat processes.

Does this approach also reduce risk?

Dr. Mamata Dhiraj Jain: Yes, each new venture learns from past mistakes, helping the system grow, improve efficiency, reduce risks, strengthen decisions, and deliver better long-term results over time.

Many would assume that building multiple ventures could dilute focus. How do you avoid that?

Dr. Dhiraj Jain: Focus comes from structure. When each venture fits into a defined framework, it becomes easier to manage multiple businesses without losing clarity.

How does this model impact the role of founders?

Dr. Mamata Dhiraj Jain: It actually strengthens their role. Founders can focus more on strategic direction and leadership, while the system supports the broader framework around them.

UAE is mentioned as an ideal environment for this kind of model. Why is that?

Dr. Dhiraj Jain: UAE provides a combination of infrastructure, access to global markets, and a supportive business environment. It creates the right conditions not just for startups, but for scalable platforms.



Is this approach limited to specific industries, or can it work across sectors?

Dr. Mamata Dhiraj Jain: It is not sector-specific. The strength of a systems-driven approach is that it can be adapted across industries, as long as the underlying structure remains strong.

What mindset shift is required for entrepreneurs to embrace this model?

Dr. Dhiraj Jain: The shift is from thinking of a business as a standalone effort to seeing it as part of a larger framework. Once that perspective changes, scaling becomes more achievable.

From an investor's perspective, what makes this approach compelling?

Dr. Mamata Dhiraj Jain: It introduces structure into growth. Instead of relying on isolated success stories, investors are looking at a platform designed to create multiple opportunities.

Looking ahead, how do you see venture-building evolving globally?

Dr. Dhiraj Jain: The future will move towards platforms, not just individual companies. The real advantage will lie in the ability to build systems that can consistently create and scale businesses.

If you had to summarise this philosophy in one line, what would it be?

Dr. Mamata Dhiraj Jain: It's not about building one successful company, it's about building a scalable system that can continuously create many successful ventures, empower innovators, inspire future entrepreneurs, generate sustainable opportunities, and contribute towards long-term economic growth, innovation, and meaningful societal transformation across generations.

“I DON'T THINK TOO MUCH ABOUT ACTING,”

Pankaj Jha's life as a painter and poet deeply influences his artistic voice and distinctive screen presence. Best known for his portrayal of **Vidhayak Ji in 'Panchayat'**, we caught up with the NSD alumnus during his recent solo exhibition - Horizon, at Triveni Kala Sangam, Delhi.

Through meditation and working on myself, I realised that the wealthiest person is the one who has the most time for himself

nearly 60-65 films, beginning with Mira Nair selecting me for 'Monsoon Wedding' from among 250 people in Delhi.

How do you ensure that your characters remain grounded in reality without becoming caricatures?

I do not care who sees me as a caricature. To me, cinema is very superficial. But among filmmakers, Majid Majidi is one of my favourites. His films 'Baran' and 'The Color of Paradise' truly move me. When a film or any form of art brings you back to the heart, that is what I call real cinema.

What draws you to the complexities of villainy, and how do you find the humanity within villains?

The word 'humanity' is a very profound thing, and what truly matters is the search for sensitivity and humanity

Which of these mediums—acting, painting, writing—do you feel most 'yourself' in?

While I was with the NSD Repertory, I also created illustrations for India Today, Hans, and several other magazines, so people knew me as an illustrator too. But naturally, I feel most at ease while painting because that is purely my own world — just me, the colours, and the canvas. I paint for my own joy and expression, without any pressure or thought of exhibition.

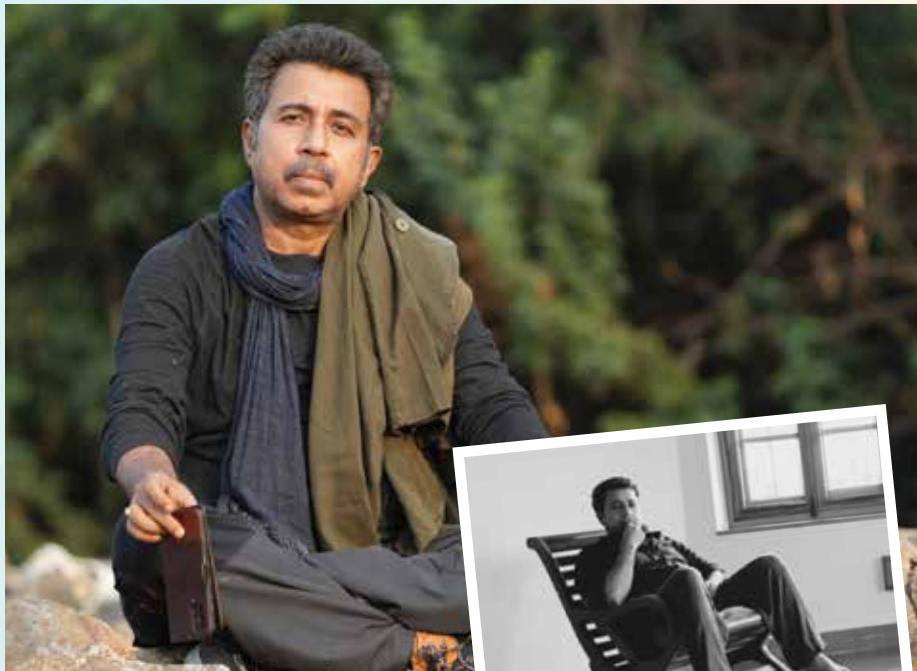
Your portrayal of Vidhayak Ji in 'Panchayat' has become iconic for its restrained menace and humour. What was the hook that helped you find the soul of this character?

If you are soulful, that soulfulness becomes visible in every character. I don't think too much about acting. Whatever comes from within me, I simply live that, and people see it as a character.

Having worked in acclaimed films like 'Monsoon Wedding', 'Company', and 'Gulaal', which role do you feel was the turning point, that truly tested your range?

I never look back or remember characters after living them. I move on completely. I've never gone around asking for work. Whatever work I got happened because someone saw one performance and offered me another. That has been my journey through





within ourselves. Osho was a great influence in my life, and I worked deeply on myself through his meditative and therapeutic processes. Society often labels people who speak the truth as dangerous or villainous. I feel the idea of a villain is much deeper than we usually think. Sometimes, in our own lives, we become our own villains by constantly trying to please people or achieve things.

What does success look like to a man who finds equal joy in a finished canvas and a well-delivered monologue?

I do not think someone else can decide success for me. Success and failure exist within your own eyes. For me, the fact that we are alive and happy is the greatest success in the world. Real joy does not come from external things; it comes from simply being yourself. Even sitting under a tree, watching birds or flowers moving in the wind, can bring immense joy.

Do you feel that poetry can express things that acting or painting cannot?

My writings may be called poems, but to me they are *sutras* of life. I feel that where words end, real life and truth actually begin. These poems or sutras simply point towards the unknown, towards the mystery of where we come from and where we go.

How has the digital space changed the game for actors like yourself?

OTT platforms and entertainment do not really change anything for me. I see cinema largely as a business. But

meaningful cinema is created out of joy and honesty. Even when 500 people watch the same film, each person is actually seeing a different film through their own experiences and emotions.

Are there any literary works or historical figures that you are yearning to bring to life on screen?

I am not eager for anything anymore. For me, cinema is meaningful in one way—it supports me financially in this worldly life. I cannot do a regular job, and cinema is simply a skill I happen to have that gives me financial support.

What can we expect from your upcoming projects, and will we see more of your poetry or art being integrated into your public life?

I live in the present moment and do not think much about the future. Right now, my second collection of poetry, 'From the Known to the Unknown', will be released. My biography, 'Misfit', is also coming out.

What one piece of advice would you give young artistes who feel they don't fit into the traditional Bollywood mould?

Bollywood is not separate from the world. Acting happens everywhere—in every household and in every relationship. Perhaps that is why Shakespeare said the whole world is a stage, and we are all actors in it ●

Social Media: Friend or Foe for Gen Z's Mental Health

Social media is no longer a choice for Gen Z; it is a reality. As the first generation to grow up entirely in the digital age, today's students experience the world through screens as much as through real-life interactions. Social media platforms influence how they communicate, learn, form relationships, and perceive themselves. While these platforms offer unprecedented opportunities for connection and learning, research increasingly urges us to examine their impact on the mental health of young minds.

Studies conducted by global health and education bodies indicate that moderate and purposeful use of social media can have positive outcomes for adolescents. Access to educational content, peer collaboration, and global awareness campaigns helps students broaden their horizons beyond textbooks. Research highlights that students who use social media for learning, creativity, and constructive interaction often demonstrate improved digital skills, confidence, and social awareness. Online platforms also provide opportunities for self-expression through art, writing, debate, and innovation—skills that align closely with 21st-century learning goals.

From a mental health perspective, social media can foster a sense of belonging. Adolescence is a stage of emotional development where acceptance and identity play a crucial role. Research shows that students who find positive peer

communities online—such as interest-based groups or academic forums—often experience emotional support and validation. Mental health awareness campaigns and peer-support initiatives on social platforms have also contributed to breaking stigmas and encouraging open conversations, making help more accessible to those who may hesitate to seek it offline.

However, research equally warns us about the risks associated with excessive and unregulated use. Psychological studies consistently link prolonged screen time with increased levels of anxiety, stress, and sleep disruption among adolescents. One major concern highlighted by researchers is social comparison. Constant exposure to curated images and idealized lifestyles creates unrealistic standards of success,

beauty, and happiness. Young minds, still developing emotional resilience, may internalize these standards, leading to low self-esteem and self-doubt.

Cyberbullying is another serious concern supported by extensive research. Unlike traditional bullying, online harassment is persistent and pervasive, often occurring anonymously and publicly. Studies indicate that victims of cyberbullying are at higher risk of emotional distress, withdrawal, and academic decline. The pressure to remain constantly connected—driven by notifications, instant responses, and the fear of missing out (FOMO)—further contributes to mental fatigue and reduced attention span.

At our school, we believe that education extends beyond academic excellence. Our core values emphasize holistic development, emotional well-being, responsible citizenship, and balance. Technology, when aligned with these values, becomes a powerful tool for growth rather than a source of harm. As educators, we recognize that the solution does not lie in banning social media, but in educating students about its responsible and mindful use.

Research strongly supports the integration of digital literacy into school curricula. Teaching students how to evaluate online content critically, manage screen time, protect personal privacy, and understand the psychological effects of social media equips them with lifelong skills. Emotional intelligence and resilience-building programs further help students navigate online challenges with confidence and maturity. When students understand that online validation does not define self-worth, they are better prepared to use social media responsibly.

Equally important is nurturing balance—an essential value we uphold as a school community. Research emphasizes the positive impact of offline engagement on mental health. Physical activity, sports, arts, reading, community service, and face-to-face interactions significantly improve emotional regulation and social skills. By encouraging participation in co-curricular activities and mindful routines, schools and families together can counter digital overload and promote healthier lifestyles.

Parental and educator involvement remains critical. Studies show that adolescents benefit most when adults model balanced digital behavior and maintain open communication rather than strict control. Regular dialogue, shared guidelines, and mutual trust help students develop self-discipline and accountability. When children feel supported rather than monitored, they are more likely to make responsible choices online. Gen Z does not need disconnection from technology; it needs direction rooted in values. Social media is neither inherently friend nor foe—it reflects the awareness with which it is used. With the right guidance, it can inspire creativity, learning, empathy, and leadership. Without boundaries, it can undermine mental health and emotional stability.

By fostering research-informed practices and value-based education, we can empower our students to navigate the digital world consciously—transforming social media into a meaningful ally in their journey of growth and well-being.

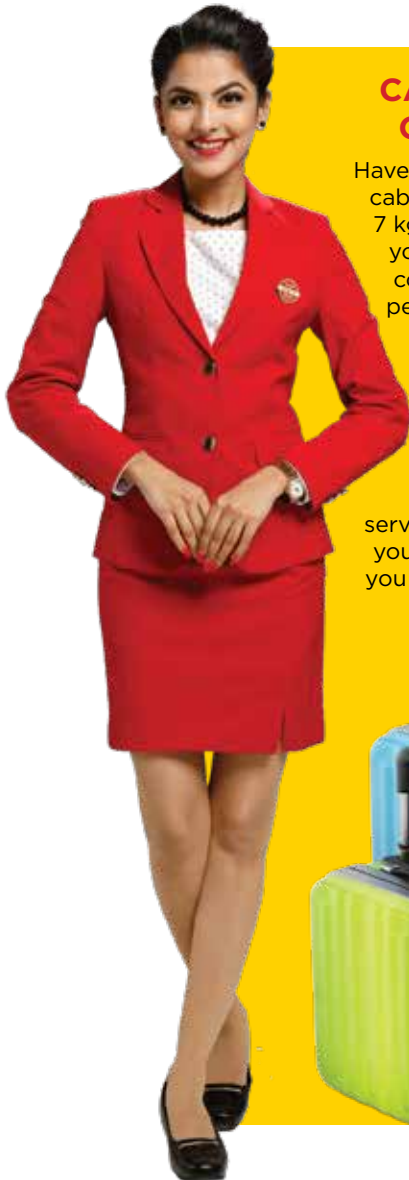

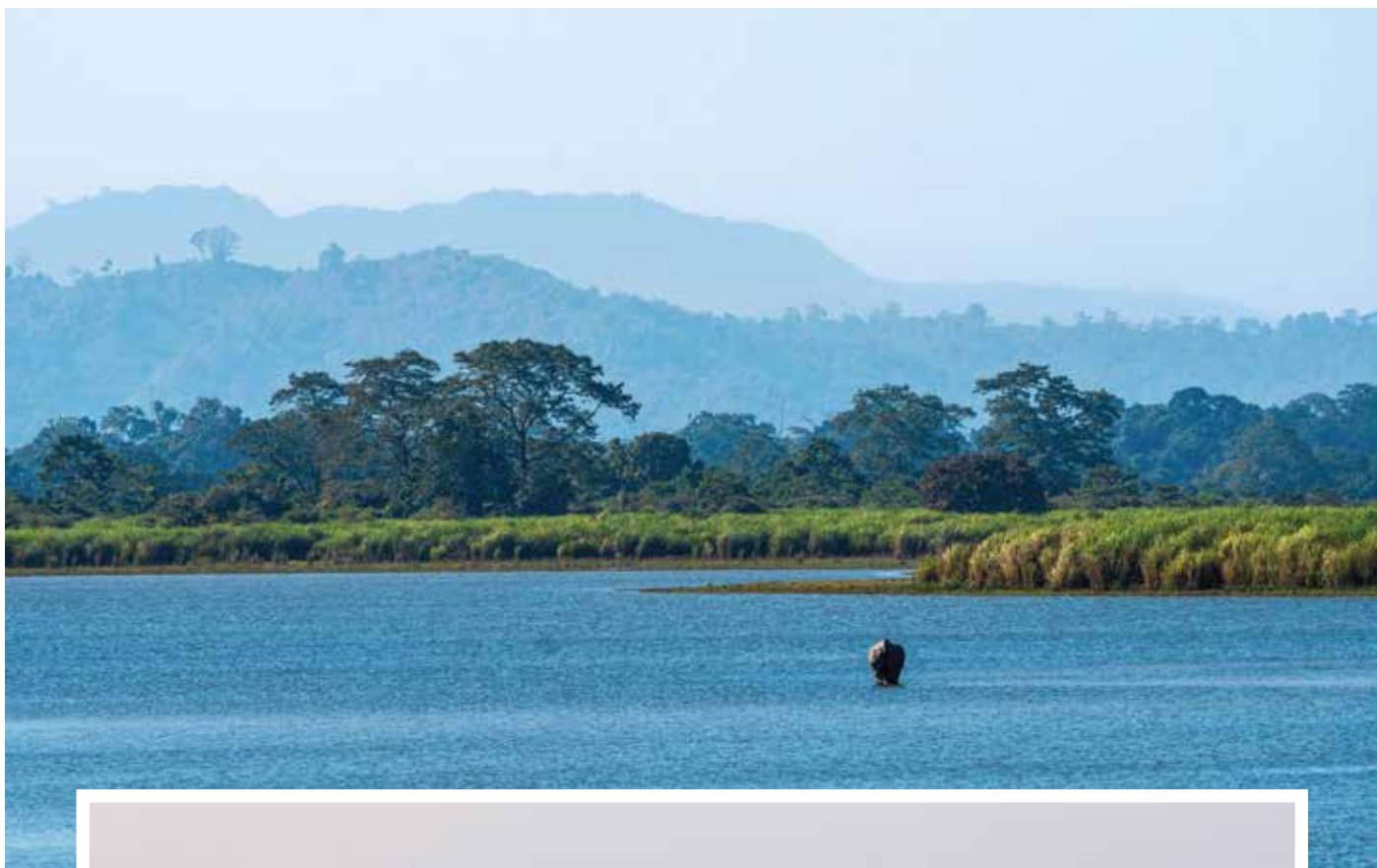


Find Me A *River*

GUWAHATI

Sandbank Sojourn

If living on a temporary sandbank was possible, Guwahati, on the banks of the mighty Brahmaputra, would be that place. The river, notorious for its monsoon floods, is actually calm and navigable in other seasons. [Entering Assam from Arunachal Pradesh, already a force of nature, and having crossed the Tibetan plateau and punched through the deep gorges of the eastern](#)

[Himalayas, the Brahmaputra is scattered and tamed by the time it rolls into the capital.](#) Still, cruises leaving from Guwahati's ghats — Uzanbazar and Fancy Bazar are departure points for boats crossing over to Umananda island (and for leisure rides) — give a sense of the river's scale. And between October and March, when the water recedes, you can camp on the sandbanks; it makes for a unique experience, knowing that the sandbar will soon disappear under the Brahmaputra.

ALLEPPEY

Backwater Bliss

Kerala's backwaters are part of an intricate and ancient riverine network, spanning 900kms of canals, lakes, and lagoons across the southern lowlands. The houseboat, or Kettuvallam, was originally a rice barge, but is now retrofitted with bedrooms, open decks, and outdoor kitchens. This is the dominant grammar of travel here, and, guided by a push-pole, a wonderfully laid-back way of acquainting yourself with this unique rural landscape. From the mighty Periyar river cutting through the lush Nilgiris to the delta country of Kuttanad, Kerala is not only about journeys on water; it's slow travel at its best.

GOA

The Susegad Way

Off the Arabian Sea lies an elaborate web of rivers, creeks, and rain-fed lakes. **This is Goa, where the Mandovi meets the ocean at Panaji, running wide and brackish over laterite soil and past mangroves. Its tidal terrain, changeable, and particularly beautiful in the mornings, before the charter boats and floating casino vessels start revving up their engines.** Opt for a traditional fishing boat adapted for a day charter, and explore the working life of the river — the ferry crossings, crab traps, and cormorants drying their wings on the channel markers. Head upstream where the mangroves thicken, motorboat traffic disappears, and the Mandovi conceals itself from the crowds. And make your way to the Dr. Salim Ali Bird Sanctuary, on the western edge of Chorao island (a short ferry ride from Ribandar); it is here that the river's ecology, and its diversity of avian species, is most visible.





SUNDARBANS

Delta Delights

In the world's largest mangrove forest, water is everywhere. The Bengal tiger moves around the delta formed by the confluence of the Ganga, Brahmaputra, and Meghna, a place of tidal creeks and mangrove islands where the tides

determine the boundary. From your boat, you look for life, scanning the muddy banks; most of the time you see the forest looking back, inscrutable. That mystery is the crux of the Sundarbans encounter. Boat safaris here typically last two-three days, on a craft — usually equipped with bunk beds and toilets — gliding through the

creeks of Sajnekhali Wildlife Sanctuary, and going deeper into Dobanki and Sudhanyakali. With a wildlife guide for company, you'll spot estuarine crocodiles and monitor lizards sliding off the banks, while spotted deer wade at the margins. Sundarbans, a World Heritage Site, is also known for its rich variety of bird species.

The wide and rocky Tungabhadra travels through Hampi gently, its course broken by enormous granite boulders, the very same that define the landscape, the ruins of the erstwhile kingdom of Vijayanagara. The coracle, a round wicker-and-tar boat, is the pride of Tungabhadra, and for centuries was the primary means of crossing the river; it still is. As it floats, the coracle spins slowly, reaching the other side in around five minutes. But those few minutes on the water present a view of the ruins that no land approach can match. Hire a boat for longer to drift past farms and quiet villages, existing as though the ancient empire along its banks was just a passing curiosity, and not the main character.

Himalayan rivers are temperamental. The Kishanganga, or Neelum, running cold and strong through the Gurez Valley near the Line of Control, has earned its isolation on the back of decades of restricted access shaping life along its banks; from the Dard-Shina villages with their timber-and-stone architecture to the pristine alpine reservoir, it flows into the Dawar village. Its shallow rapids navigate gorges and

valleys, freezing in the winter like an icy dream. The Lidder River, by contrast, traverses stretches that most travellers carry in their imagination. Pine-framed and white-hued, it moves fast through Pahalgam, and the eponymous valley, then descends, before rising near the Kolahoi glacier, where its colour is an opaque grey-green. Trout gather in deep pools beneath the willows, and along the banks, daily life continues undisturbed: ponies crossing the shallow fords and woodsmoke drifting down from the hillside villages ●

MADURAI

A TOWN AROUND A TEMPLE

MEENAKSHI J.

Bustling Madurai's streets and markets rarely seem to pause. A day in Thoonga Nagaram, the city that never sleeps, takes shape around the Meenakshi Amman temple, with several revisits along the way.

1 HALLOWED GROUND

Rise early for the first rituals of the day at the Meenakshi Amman Temple, when its long corridors are still relatively less crowded. Immerse yourself in Pandya lore and the ancient Hindu epics, ornately detailed on the ceilings and pillars, across the corridors and the 14 vibrant gopurams, and within the sub-shrines dedicated to the Hindu pantheon. While inside the complex, don't miss the 1,000-pillared Aayiram Kaal Mandapam, many of whose columns produce distinct musical notes.

Next stop: Breakfast, a short walk away

2 A SCRUMPTIOUS START

Step out onto West or East Masi streets, around where age-old eateries serve delicious idli, pongal, vada, and poori-masala, finished off with strong filter coffee. For something more leisurely, the reliable Murugan Idli Shop is known for its idlis and chutneys.

Next stop: Stroll through the markets



3 AROUND THE TEMPLE

The lanes and alleys around Meenakshi Amman are already decorated with kolam in the early hours, especially the Masi streets, where the city's everyday life unfolds. Flower sellers string together Madurai jasmine, the fragrant garlands of which catch the morning light, as shops open one shutter at a time. Make time for Pudhu Mandapam, the pillared hall opposite the temple, now filled with tailors, sellers of brass items, bookbinders, and small traders. It's part market, part relic of an older Madurai.

Next stop: 10-15 minutes' drive

4 QUICK MUSEUM STOP

As morning makes way for noon, step inside the Gandhi Memorial Museum, located within the historic Rani Mangammal Palace. Letters, photographs, and objects such as a bloodstained cloth worn by Mahatma Gandhi, trace moments and signposts from India's freedom movement. The museum is a sneak peek into India's history, and the regal architecture of the palace is worth admiring.

Next stop: Lunch nearby

5 MADURAI MEAL

When in Madurai, lunch is best taken as a proper, sit-down meal. A traditional South Indian saapadu of rice, sambar, rasam, vegetables and curd is both filling and restorative. The eateries surrounding the temple continue to serve simple, well-made food in both fixed and unlimited portions.

Next stop: Breather, followed by a short drive





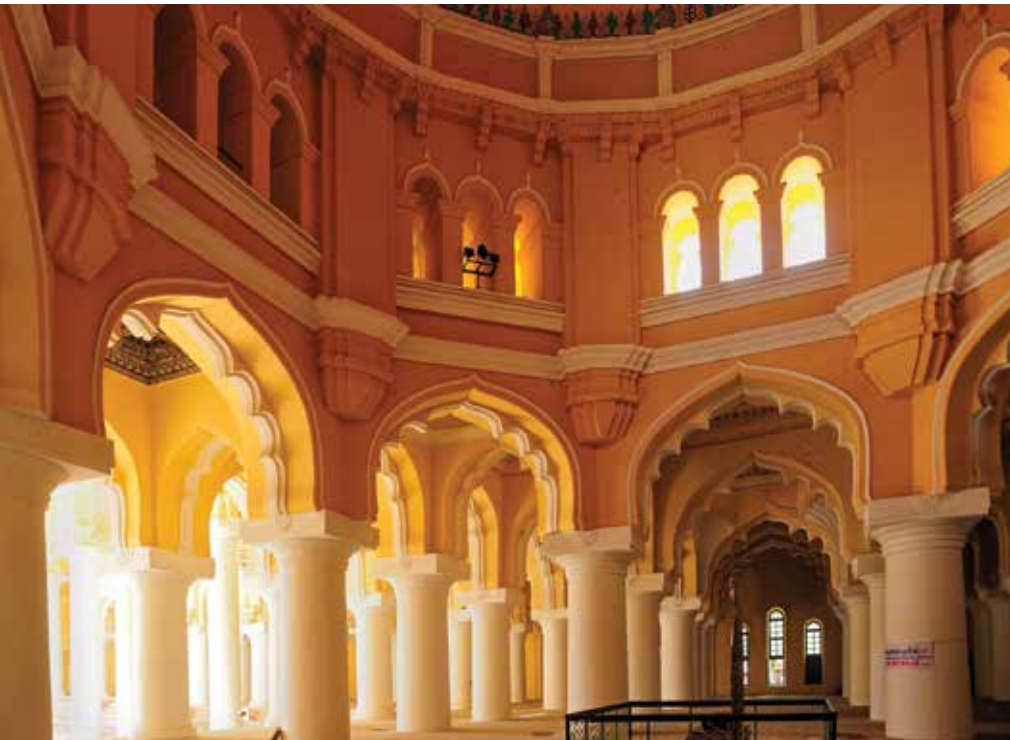
6 ABODE OF MURUGAN

The 8th-century Thiruparankundram Murugan Temple, one of Murugan's six abodes, offers a chance to extend your temple circuit a little further, before returning to the city. Set against a rocky hill, this shrine, with its cool interiors and tranquil corridors, is usually quiet on non-festive days.

Next stop: Drive back to Madurai

7 PALACE INTERLUDE

Stop by the majestic Thirumalai Nayakkar near the city centre, a classic fusion of Indo-Islamic architecture (with strong shades of Europe), and admire its high arches, colonnaded halls, and spacious



courtyards. Stay back for a riveting sound-and-light show, and learn about the palace's 17th-century origins and history..

Next stop: 15 minutes' drive

8 TWILIGHT AT THE TEMPLE

Return to Meenakshi Amman as night falls, its courtyards bathed in the soft light of dusk. The atmosphere is different now, and a lot busier. If you can, stay for the late-evening ceremony,

and surrender to the devotional atmosphere as the processional deity is carried through the corridors amid Vedic chants.

Next stop: 20 minutes' drive

9 DINING IN STYLE

Dinner at the Sterling V Grand Madurai is an experience in itself. Grand Ayyanar, the hotel's multi-cuisine restaurant, serves authentic Madurai delicacies alongside Indian and global favourites. Guests can

look forward to elaborate buffets, live counters and interactive kitchens, while savouring regional specialities such as Kari Dosa and Chettinad gravies. However, despite the awareness, the world is currently facing three interlinked crises, climate change, **biodiversity loss, and pollution.**

Observed annually on 5 June, World Environment Day was established by the United Nations in 1972 during the Stockholm Conference on the Human Environment, and first celebrated in 1973.

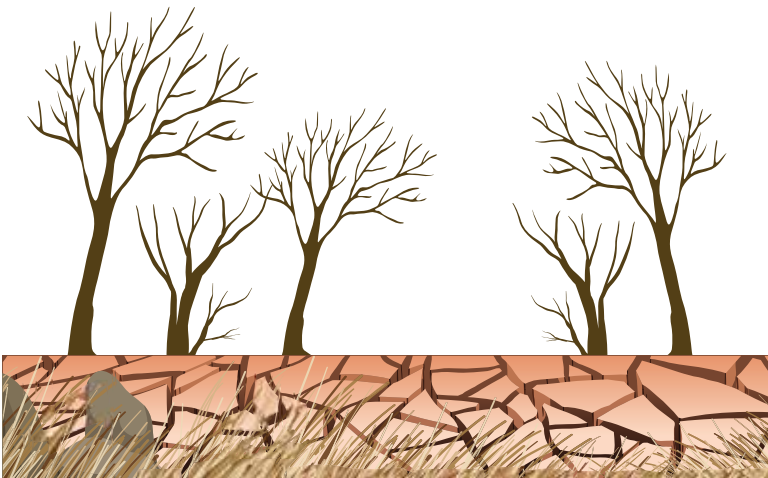


Over fifty years since its inception, it is regarded as the world's largest environmental outreach platform, with participation from over **150 COUNTRIES** and engagement that reaches millions of people globally.

Global temperatures have already risen by approximately 1.1°C above pre-industrial levels, contributing to more frequent and intense heatwaves, floods, and droughts. At the same time, nearly **1 million species** are at risk of extinction, while plastic pollution continues to grow at an alarming pace, affecting both terrestrial and marine ecosystems.



Encouragingly, India has made notable progress in clean energy. Over **50% of installed electricity** capacity now comes from non-fossil fuel sources, including solar, wind, hydro, and nuclear.



Climate vulnerability is becoming increasingly visible. India has witnessed a growing frequency of extreme weather events, including prolonged heatwaves, **erratic rainfall, and floods, all of which have direct implications for agriculture, livelihoods, and urban infrastructure.**

However, environmental pressures remain significant. **India generates approximately 3.5 million tonnes of plastic waste annually.** Water pollution is another area of concern, with around 311 polluted river stretches identified in 2022, indicating persistent stress on freshwater resources.



In response, policy measures have been strengthened. The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has introduced frameworks such as **Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) for plastics and e-waste**, expanded renewable energy capacity, and scaled up climate adaptation strategies. These efforts aim to balance economic growth with environmental sustainability while addressing both mitigation and resilience.

Taken together, these figures present a dual narrative, one of progress and one of pressure. As the world marks World Environment Day 2026, the data serves as a clear reminder that while meaningful strides are being made, the scale and urgency of environmental challenges demand sustained, collective action.

The untamed beauty



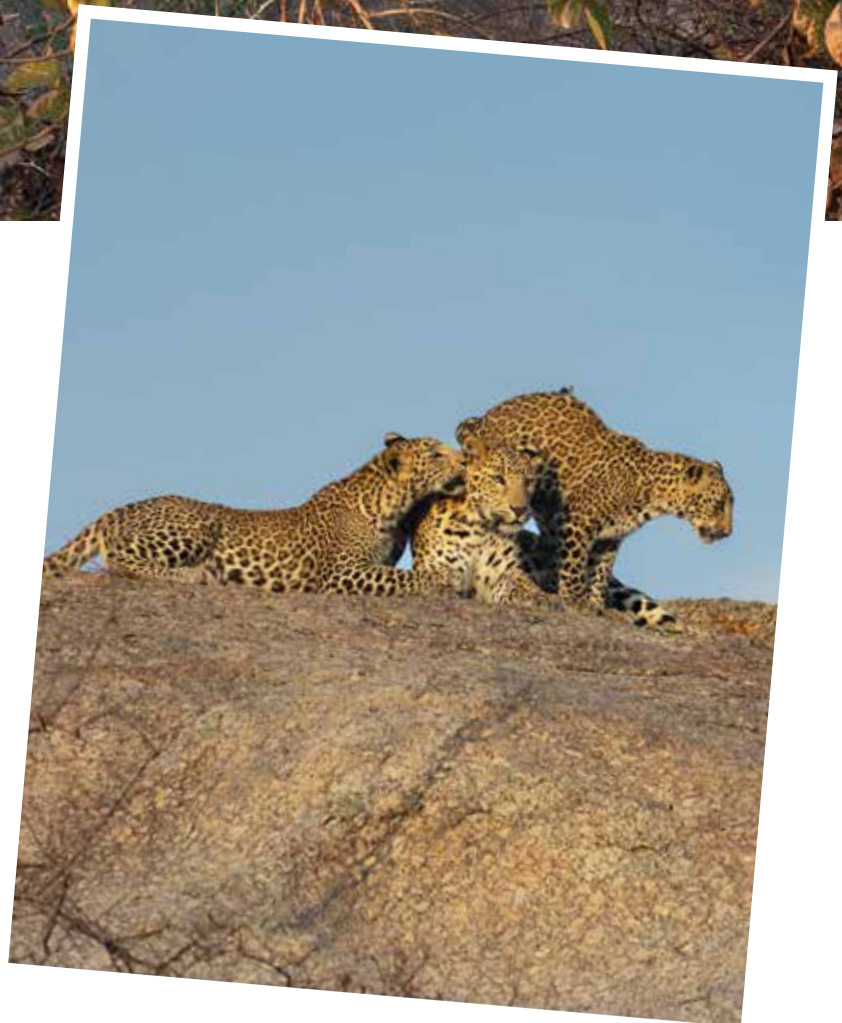

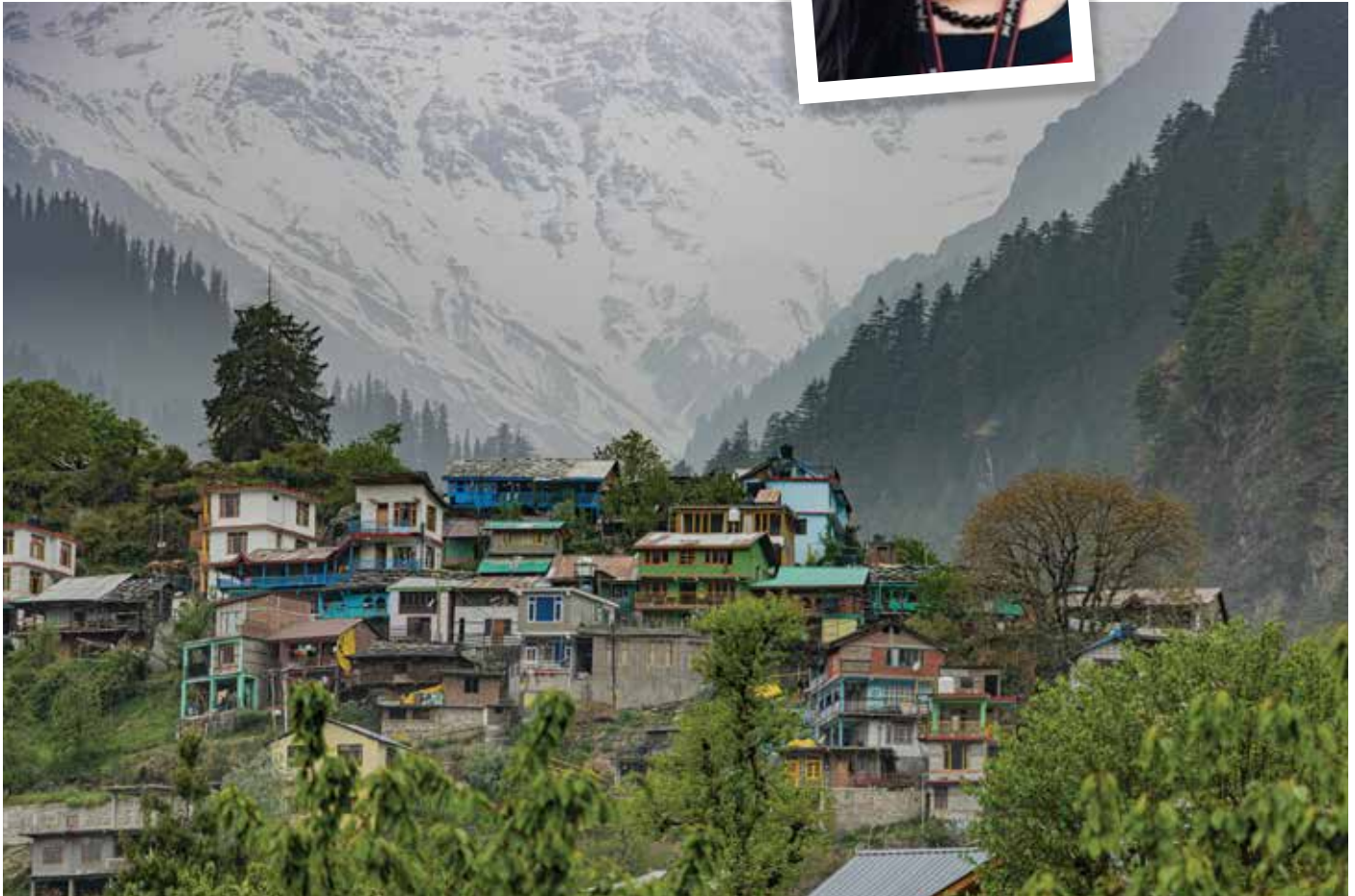


My Town

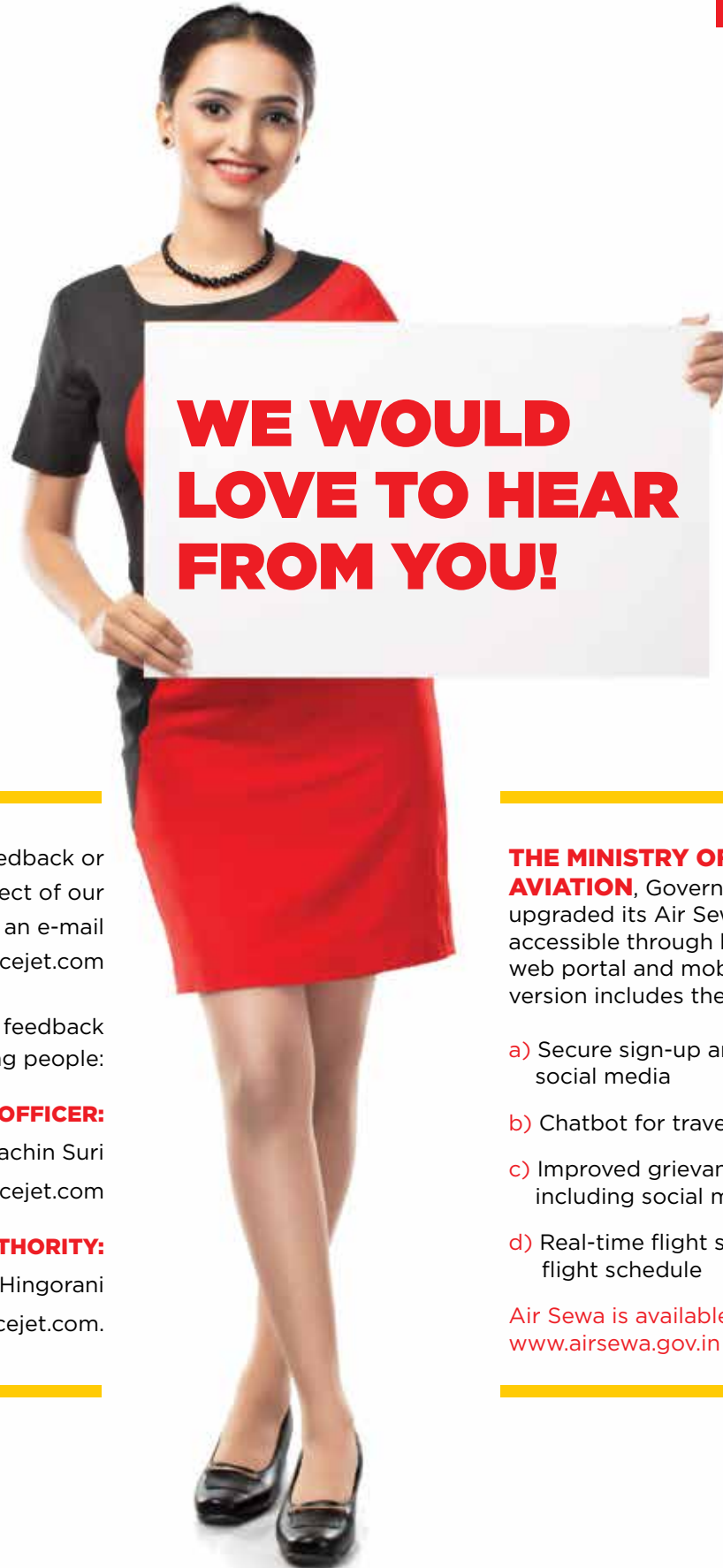
